The school will continue to provide Breakfast Club every day and Stay and Play on three afternoons.

Unfortunately, at the moment Stay and Play can only be offered until 4:30pm due to staffing arrangements.

I think there could have been better communication between class teachers and families during lockdown, particularly with the younger pupils who couldn't really access class dojo independently

The majority of parents were happy with the communication between class teachers and families, however, we will look for further ways to further improve this.

Staggering pick up and drop offs to ease car park congestion

This has been done to meet with the COVID health and safety risk assessment and is working well.

More regular contact with teacher between parents evenings. Dojo and zoom have worked really well.

Class Dojo will be maintained as a way for regular contact between parents and school going forwards.

I have been quite disappointed at the email requests for responses by parents by 5pm that same day (in particular the request to know if parent wished to send children back in June). I appreciate the school has had a lot to juggle in the COVID climate however it can be very challenging not only for 1 parent to reply but for both to be involved in a decision by 5pm that same day.

Responses from parents will be pushed back to 6:30pm, moving forwards.
