However is there any possibility of them getting changed at school for PE and returning it when it needs washed. As currently the white tops usually are either covered in lunch/paint/mud by the end of the day with them being on a full day.

The 'first come first served' approach to allocating spaces in school clubs doesn't seem fair. If you as a parent don't your check emails regularly you end up letting your child down by not replying quickly enough and being told they've missed out on a place. It also means that the family feel under pressure to make quick decisions about clubs rather than giving it consideration. This method could mean that some children get their full choice of clubs every term, whilst other children miss out every time as their parents weren't quick enough checking their emails.
