journey onwards to eternal life

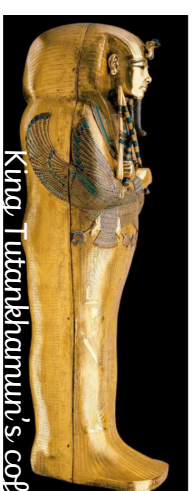
Field of Reeds
