General Information for school opening September 2021 (following CCC Risk Assessment)

Attendance expectations

School will monitor attendance and any absence will be followed up. If your child is going to be absent please contact the school before 9.00am to let us know. Any child testing positive for Covid will need to self-isolate for 10 days. Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time, arriving late can impact the learning of the class.

<u>Uniform</u>

Please wear full <u>school uniform</u> with our logo on: navy sweatshirt, royal blue or white polo shirt, grey/black trousers/skirt/safe **black/navy/brown school shoes (no laces if your child cannot tie them)** and long hair tied back. Uniform is available to buy from Price and Buckland. Nursery are encouraged to wear school uniform that is **easy for the child to remove and pull up themselves** for toileting. Please ensure that your child/ren have **Wellington boots which can be left in school.** These are essential for outdoor play on the field.

<u>PE Kit</u>

Please provide a full school PE kit for Reception children upwards: pale blue polo/white t-shirt, navy blue/black shorts and joggers, spare socks and trainers. On days, that it is PE we will request that your child comes dressed for PE and earrings are removed (taped with micro pore if within six weeks of being newly done).

Book bags

School book bags may be used - there is no requirement to use the clear bags unless you wish to.

Water bottles and Snack

Please bring in your own water bottle refilled each day with fresh water. A piece of fruit can be brought in as a healthy snack (Y 3 -6). Children in YN – Y2 are entitled to free fruit through the Government scheme.

Access to the school site.

Currently we will continue to limit access to the school site and we would encourage parents not to get out of their cars. Should you wish to speak with a staff member/school admin, please telephone to arrange an appointment at a mutually convenient time.

Arrangements for drop off and pick up

Drop off and Pick up times have been sent out via email. This arrangement will be reviewed at the end of September. Please be on time and **only drop off when it is your turn by the gate**. (Health and Safety)

CCC School Transport

Please contact your taxi driver for times. Buses will arrive for 8:35am /leave 3:25pm.

Classroom Equipment

We will encourage children to use individual pencil cases provided by the school. The use of other resources and equipment will be monitored with increased hygiene measures in place.

Hand washing and Toilets

Hygiene will continue to be a priority. Sinks and toilets will be cleaned regularly. Please remind your child of how to wash and dry hands and how important it is that they avoid touching their face / picking their nose / sucking their fingers. Please also remind everyone to 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' by coughing or sneezing into a tissue or their elbow. Please wash hands before coming to school. Sanitising gel will continue available in the reception and throughout school. We also have E45 cream available to prevent sore hands. Please inform us if your child has medical needs.

Food and Drinks

Orian will continue to provide our school meals boxed and ready to eat. Each class will be eating in their own classroom.

Stay and Play

Stay and Play will be available to pre-book (Tuesday – Thursday) starting from Thursday 2nd September, contact the school office to book in advance.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will be available from Thursday 2nd September and must be booked in advance. Please contact the school office to make a booking, last minute bookings must be made by **1:00pm on the day** before club is required, and are subject to space availability.

Parent / Carer

To help my child at school, I understand that:

- If I wish to come into school I will make an appointment via telephone or email.
- I will communicate with the school either via emailor via a phone call in a respectful manner.
- I need to inform the school immediately of changes to my child's medical needs and parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
